Individual Support Service, an intensive therapeutic support programme for children with emotional and behavioural difficulties which improves relationships, develops coping skills and promotes positive behaviours. One to one weekly sessions are provided by professionally trained staff in the child's own home or other suitable environment. Sessions are available out of hours and can be provided face to face, online or by phone depending upon the child's needs and preferences.

The service in Wicklow particularly targets children and young people between the ages of 10-18 years who are at increased risk of harm due to drug or alcohol misuse. This risk may be identified due to their own experimental use of drugs or alcohol, their involvement with known users, a family history of drug or alcohol use or the fact that they are living in an area of known disadvantage making them potentially more at risk of drug or alcohol use.

Childline/Teenline, a free, 24 hour comprehensive listening and support service available to all children by phone, text or online. All volunteers complete a comprehensive training course covering a wide range of issues including responding to children who present with concerns in relation to drug and alcohol issues.

Non-Violent Resistance Programme: an evidence-based parenting course promoting effective communication and positive relationships in families. It is designed to bring violence and aggression to an end and to build a better and stronger relationship between parents and their children. The programme is delivered in a group setting or with individuals over a ten week period.
